What informs KPI creation?

### **Terminology**

- 1. **Key Performance Indicator (KPI)**: a quantifiable measure used to evaluate the success of an organization, employee, etc. in meeting objectives for performance.
- S.M.A.R.T.: Specific (simple, sensible, significant). Measurable (meaningful, motivating).
   Achievable (agreed, attainable). Relevant (reasonable, realistic and resourced, results-based). Time bound (time-based, time limited, time/cost limited, timely, time-sensitive).

## **Beginner**

Organizational KPIs are created based on compliance with grant, legal, or budget requirements

#### Intermediate

Organizational KPIs are created based on data-driven analysis and compliance with grant, legal, or budget requirements. Data-driven analysis may include information collected from pets in care, lost and found reports, foster data, medical data, or other tracking done by the organization.

### Advanced

**S.M.A.R.T.** KPIs are created based on data-driven analysis and compliance with grant, legal, or budget requirements. Data-driven analysis may include information collected from pets in care, lost and found reports, foster data, medical data, supported self-rehoming data, pet support, case management, or other tracking done by the organization. Staff, volunteers, and key stakeholders may contribute to KPI creation.
