

HASS Rubric: Foundations

What type of data is the organization tracking?

Beginner

Every animal is counted regardless of the reason for intake, outcome, or service. The organization tracks basic data information for pets in care including **all** of the following:

Intake Types

- Stray/At large
- Relinquished by owner
- Returned to shelter
- Transfer-in
- Seized/Confiscated
- Owner requested euthanasia (ORE)

Live Outcomes

- Adoption
- Return to owner (RTO)
- Transfer out
- Shelter Neuter Return (SNR)
- Other live outcome

Other Outcomes

- Died in care
- Missing/Lost/Stolen
- Euthanasia

Totals (Cats/dogs/other/all animals separately)

- Total live intake
- Total live outcomes
- Total other outcomes
- Total in care (beginning and ending of tracking period)
- Total in foster care (beginning and ending of tracking period)

Intermediate

Every animal is counted regardless of the reason for intake, outcome, or service. The organization tracks basic data information (*Beginner section, above*) **plus** the following information:

- Microchip information is entered for all animals in care
- Lost and found reports are tracked (if applicable)
- Foster movement and status are tracked (if applicable)



• Volunteer hours are tracked (if applicable)

Advanced

Every animal is counted regardless of the reason for intake, outcome, or service. The organization tracks basic data information (*Beginner section, above*) **plus** the following information:

- Microchip information is entered for all animals in care
- Lost and found reports are tracked (if applicable)
- Foster movement and status are tracked (if applicable)
- Volunteer hours are tracked (if applicable)
- Supported self-rehoming data
- People and pets served through pet support or case management services
