

HASS Rubric: Intake-to-Placement

Do Field Services Officers assist with pet pathway planning?

Beginner

Field Services Officers collaborate with shelter staff to identify opportunities for foster or rescue placement for pets about to enter the care of the shelter or are at risk of relinquishment. This may include flagging pets as potential candidates for breed-specific rescues, foster-preferred due to behavior or medical considerations, and more to help the intake to placement process. Officers also notify the shelter if the finder of a lost pet is interested in fostering and/or adopting if reunification is not possible with the primary owner.
