



HASS Rubric: Intake-to-Placement

Does the organization have a foster-on-deck list?

Terminology

1. **Foster-On-Deck:** Information collected from foster interest forms including pets a person is interested in, qualities they are looking for, and current home set up is captured in a centralized spreadsheet or data location. This information is referenced to assist in matchmaking efforts for pets in care and pets incoming.

Beginner

Organization accepts ongoing foster interest forms/requests. Interest forms may be collected for general foster interest and placed in a queue or on-deck list or for a specific pet available for foster. Foster recruitment efforts are shared once per quarter through official organization communication channels such as newsletters or social media posts.

Intermediate

Organization accepts ongoing foster interest forms/requests. Interest forms are collected for general foster interest and placed in a queue or on-deck list or for a specific pet available for foster. Foster recruitment efforts are shared once per month through official organization communication channels.

Advanced

Organization has created a foster-on-deck list and is continuously recruiting fosters. Potential fosters are collected for general foster interest and placed in a queue or on-deck list or with specific pets in mind. The foster-on-deck list is utilized in matchmaking for potential fosters who have not yet been matched with a pet.
