



HASS Rubric: Lost Pet Reunification

Does the organization provide support repairing fences and securing yards?

Beginner

The organization provides information about external organizations or programs that may offer assistance to the public to repair fences and secure yards. External organizations may include local businesses, non-profit groups, or existing programs that may offer support repairing fences, but are **not** currently an established partner with your shelter. All recommendations are information-only including the name of the program or business and basic contact information. The organization also provides general information detailing how and why dogs commonly escape, and effective prevention.

Intermediate

The organization provides assistance to the public to repair fences and secure yards through referrals or local/national partnerships with programs that are confirmed to offer this type of support. An established partnership should at a minimum include a signed agreement by both parties and clearly outlined expectations or expected results of the partnership. Support may include funding, supplies, tools, or direct labor. The organization also provides general information detailing how and why dogs commonly escape, and effective prevention.

Advanced

The organization provides assistance directly to the public to help repair fences and secure yards. Direct assistance may include:

- Funding
- Supplies and/or fence-mending tools
- Staff or Volunteers equipped to provide physical assistance with repairs

The organization also provides general information detailing how and why dogs commonly escape, and effective prevention, as well as specific guidance to assist individuals to secure their own environments.
