How do Field Services Officers share self-rehoming information?

Beginner

Supported self-rehoming resources are made available to the public during in-person interactions, such as an individual engaging with an officer responding to a call in the field. Resources for supported self-rehoming **may include** websites pet owners can use to get started, best practices for marketing pets, and options for free or low-cost support (such as medical care) that may help the pet get adopted faster.

Intermediate

Supported self-rehoming resources are made available to the public during in-person or phone interactions and an established website for field operations or animal services. The website may have a dedicated landing page for support services and how to get started rehoming a pet with support.

Advanced

Supported self-rehoming resources are made available to the public during in-person or phone interactions and on a website for field operations or animal services. These resources are also accessible on the organization's applicable social media pages.
